

Scenic Eclipse Continues its Build to Completion and June Sea Trials

Boston & Vancouver, May 2019 – In response to a commercial court ruling in Pazin, Croatia, placing Uljanik Shipyard into bankruptcy this week, with expectations of the same next week for the holding company, Uljanik Group, Scenic has negotiated an agreement with the court-appointed bankruptcy trustee to ensure the work on *Scenic Eclipse* continues uninterrupted until her completion and delivery. The ship will then head to Reykjavik, Iceland for its inaugural cruise on August 15.

This bankruptcy development comes after a breakdown in negotiations between the recently chosen strategic partner, Brodosplit Shipyard and the Croatian Government. The strategic partner is a consortium comprised of the Croatian DIV group and Italian Shipyard Fincantieri.

"The *Scenic Eclipse* continues to remain on schedule for its first sea trial in early June after its completion of the dry dock work last week," states a Scenic company spokesperson. "We are saddened by the loss of jobs at the shipyard as we have developed a wonderful relationship with many of the hard-working men and women there and hope that a court-determined resolution is found in the near future."
